Vacancies for psychoanalytic psychotherapists

We invite enquiries from professional colleagues who would like to join a small dynamic psychoanalytic psychotherapy organisation.

The Inner City Centre, founded in 1981, is an organisation of around 50 qualified psychoanalytic psychotherapists, i.e. members of the BPC or the UKCP Council for Psychoanalysis and Jungian Analysis (CPJA). The organisation was originally set up to provide accessible psychoanalytic psychotherapy to people in the City of London and the East End. This ethos remains a guiding principle for its current membership.

Members work in ICC consulting rooms in the City or their own consulting rooms in London. Patients are referred to members via an accessible and professional referral service run by two Referral Therapists.

Most ICC patients come from the City, East London and North East London. Members who work outside these areas are therefore encouraged to use the consulting rooms in the City, where there is a better flow of patients.

Most patients are offered open-ended individual therapy but there is also an ICC analytic group run by a member of the IGA, and a Brief Therapy Project offering various models of time-limited therapy. We also offer couple therapy.

Members are expected to take on a variety of cases, with at least two low-fee patients in their caseload at any one time. The annual membership subscription is £150 and referral fees are payable for each patient who remains in treatment. The ICC maintains patient statistics, currently using the CORE evaluation system.

The ICC is a registered charity. It is managed by an elected Council of member Trustees including some appointed external Trustees. Publicity, fund-raising, professional development and membership matters are all run by members.

The membership is offered CPD events termly and occasional seminar series. This programme is about to expand to include peer supervision, a reading group and more seminar series. Mentoring and supervision is also offered for newly-qualified members. There are also social events, fund-raising events and communication between members via centrechat and the distribution of all minutes from Council to the membership.
